We have initiated a summer program for the next few years as well as before and after school programs that offer additional support. Teachers will also be adjusting curriculum to ensure students are reengaging in the necessary timeframe.
<b>Code 16</b> Support Staff Salaries	Bus drivers-The district will be providing transportation for our summer school program. This has not been offered in prior years and will make assist parents and increase participation for students in need. This is planned for the next few years. Also, a 5 p.m. after school bus will begin the first full week of school and will run Monday – Thursdays during the school year. This will help students who require additional homework assistance while taking the burden of transporting off the parents.
