- Each district received an entitlement, unlimited time frame
- To be used in 5 different categories

School connectivity
Community connectivity
Classroom learning technology
Pre-Kindergarten learning classrooms
Replace transportable classrooms
High tech security

Submit a Smart School Investment Plan (SSIP) to NYSED

## Holley's Entitlement-\$1,311,463

- Original application started with 2017-18 budget
- Approved on June, 2019
- Total anticipated budget \$561,000
- Plan:
  - Flat panels(Interactive Whiteboards)-33
  - Laptops-200 student/20 teacher
  - Carts-5
  - New security software and cameras

Actual expense-\$497,104

Purchased 33 Flatpanels \$120,218

Purchased 220 Laptops \$121,880

\$ 5,495

Purchased 5 Laptop Carts

Security program & cameras \$249,511

Total SSBA allocation \$1,311,463

Purchase (33) Flat panels (Interactive Whiteboards)

\$120,000

1/3 of Flat panels purchased and installed in 2019-20 (application #1)

1/3 of Flat panels purchased with Application #4

- Existing Category 5 Ethernet Cables are 10-12 years old
- Replace and add Category 6 Ethernet Cables
- Ensuring all classrooms have at least 5 drops
  - Flat panel
  - Teacher computer
  - Action tech device
  - Voice over IP
  - Wireless access point
- In addition, the offices, auditorium and computer labs will be replaced.
- Category 6 is known to have better communication
  - Monroe 1 BOCES(Regional Information Center-RIC)
  - majority of our servers are located
- Approximate cost is \$400,000.

#### Process to submit

- Presented to the Board of Education the preliminary plan at the June 18<sup>th</sup> meeting
- Go over details with District technology committee on November 17, 2021, which will include a couple community members
- Meet with students (November 4, 2021)
- Post 30 days on the website and have power point available at District Office.
- Hold a hearing prior to the Board of Education meeting on December 20<sup>th</sup>
- BOE approval of the final SSIP for applications #4 on December 20<sup>th</sup>
- Complete and submit a Smart School Investment Plan to NYSED by mid-January, 2022
