Dear Hawk Families,

Holley Middle/High School will be conducting Final/Regent's exams June 12, 2023 – June 22, 2023. During Final/Regent's exam there will be a modified schedule. Students will only report to take their exam. Transportation will be provided for students.

There are morning sessions from 7:30-10:00 am and afternoon sessions from 11:30-2:00 pm. If students have a morning and afternoon session on the same day, they will be provided lunch and supervised in between the two sessions. Students in grades 9-12 may leave after the morning session and return for the afternoon session only if they have a note written by a parent. If students only have a morning session, they will receive breakfast, be dismissed at 10:00 am and transportation will be provided home. If students only have an afternoon session, transportation will be provided, they arrive at 11:30 am. Students taking afternoon exams will be dismissed at 2:00 pm.

All students must stay for the entire session. If a student needs more than two-and-a-half hours for a Regents exam, they can stay for up to three hours. Any student requiring more time will be dismissed on a case-by-case basis. Monday, June 19, 2023, is a federal holiday and therefore there is no school.

Varsity/JV: Opens July 21 Modified: Opens July 28

- All registration must be completed through Family ID.
 The Family ID registration link is available on the Athletics tab of the school website.
- Please register early to give time for your registration to be approved.
- Dr. Goetz will be at the High School August 9th @10am. In order to play a Fall Sport, a current physical exam needs to be on file in the Health Office. If an athlete gets a physical from their own physician, they must submit a copy to the Health Office.
- Athletic Placement Physical Fitness Testing August
 14th @ 9am 7th and 8th grade students who have
 been asked to participate at JV/Varsity levels must
 take the fitness test. Before taking the fitness test,
 students must have parent/guardian permission and
 medical clearance by the school medical director (Dr.
 Goetz).
- Fall meeting for all athletes and parents involved in varsity, JV, or modified sports will be **September 5th @ 6pm**, following Back-To-School Night. The meeting is to cover rules and regulations with athletes and parents.

Varsity/JV: August 21

Modified: August 28 (Note modified sports can start before school this year)

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Message from the Nurse

Dr. Goetz will be doing sports physicals on 8/9/23 at 10am. Please call the main office to sign up. If you plan on playing a fall sport, your physical must be current. Please call your doctor's office to see when your child's last physical was performed. The school nurse has limited hours in the summer and will not be in her office daily.

All students entering 7th, 9th, and 11th grade need to have an updated physical per NYS regulations for the 2023-2024 school year. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the MS/HS Health office (585)638-6335 ext. 5100.

In accordance with NYS Department of Health, all students entering grades 7th and 12th in the 2023-2024 school year are required to have a Meningococcal Vaccine (Meningitis). Students have 14 calendar days from the first day of the new school year to complete this requirement or they will not be able to attend. Please contact your physician's office to make arrangements or contact the Orleans County Health Department at (585)589-3278 for immunization clinic information. Library


